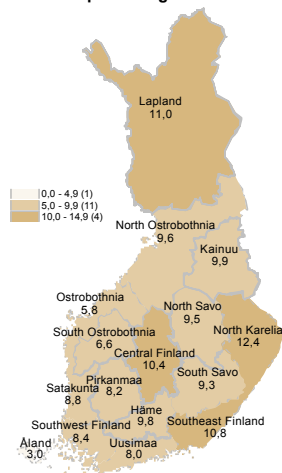

In October 230,100 unemployed jobseekers

A total of 230,100 unemployed jobseekers were registered at the Employment and Economic Development Offices at the end of October. This is 42,400 less than a year earlier. The number of unemployed jobseekers decreased by 1,900 from the previous month. Unemployed jobseekers accounted for 8.7% of the labour force, which is 1.7 percentage points less than a year ago. The figures are from the Employment Service Statistics of the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment.

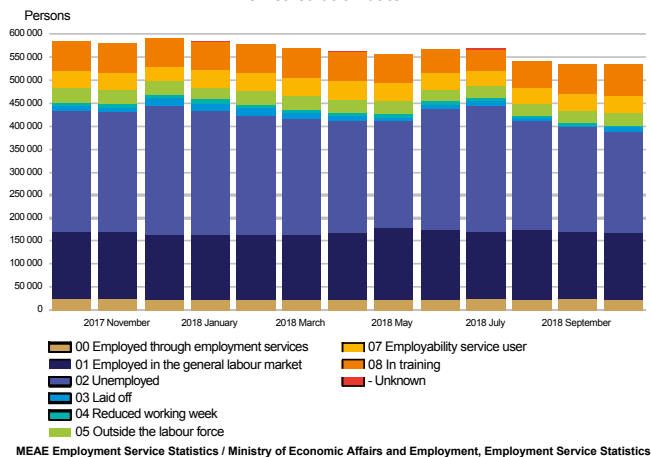

The total number of jobseekers decreased

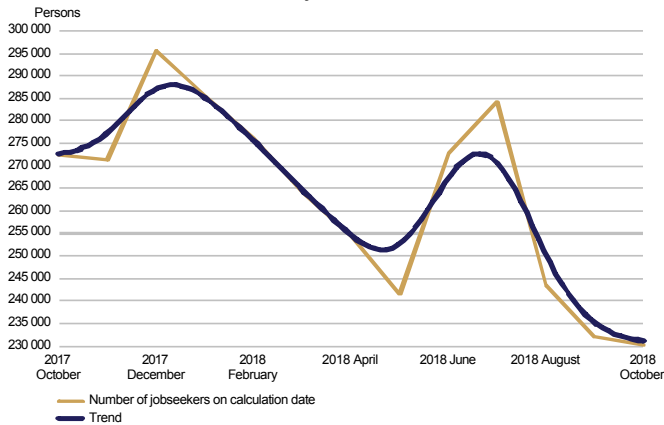
At the end of October, the number of jobseekers registered at the Employment and Economic Development Offices totalled 532,600, down 50,900 on the previous year. Of the jobseekers, 261,600 were men and 271,000 were women. Compared to the situation a year ago, the number of men decreased by 26,500 and the number of women by 24,400.

Of the jobseekers, 166,300 were employed, 141,900 of them were on the open labour market and 24,300 were employed through the services of the employment and economic development administration. The number of jobseekers outside the labour force was 130,200, of whom 38,300 were in services promoting employment and 66,200 in training. Of the jobseekers, 230,100 were unemployed jobseekers, which is 42,400 less than the year before. In October, 8,000 of unemployed jobseekers were fully laid off, which is 1,300 more than in September. Since October last year, the number of people fully laid off has decreased by 2,100. Furthermore, jobseekers on a reduced working week numbered 6,000, representing a decrease of 2,400 from the year before.

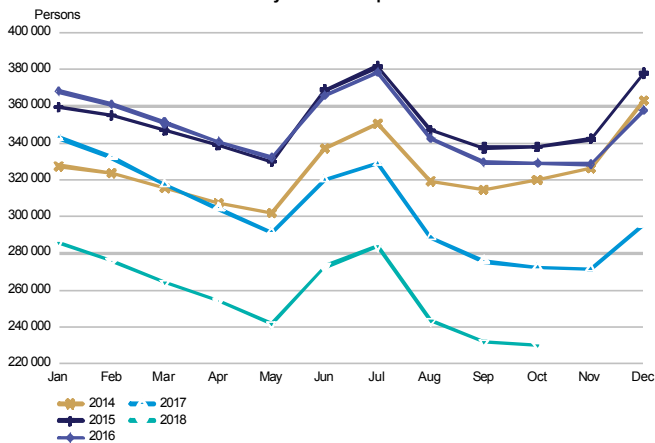
Decrease in unemployed jobseekers in October

At the end of October, the number of unemployed jobseekers registered at the Employment and Economic Development Offices totalled 230,100, down 42,400 on the previous year. Compared with September, the number of unemployed jobseekers decreased by 1,900.

In October, 8,000 of unemployed jobseekers were fully laid off, which is 1,300 more than in September. Since October last year, the number of people fully laid off has decreased by 2,100.

The number of foreign citizens among unemployed jobseekers totalled 23,000, down 3,900 from October a year ago. Of these foreign unemployed jobseekers, EU/EEA citizens accounted for 6,800 at the end of October, down 1,100 from the year before.

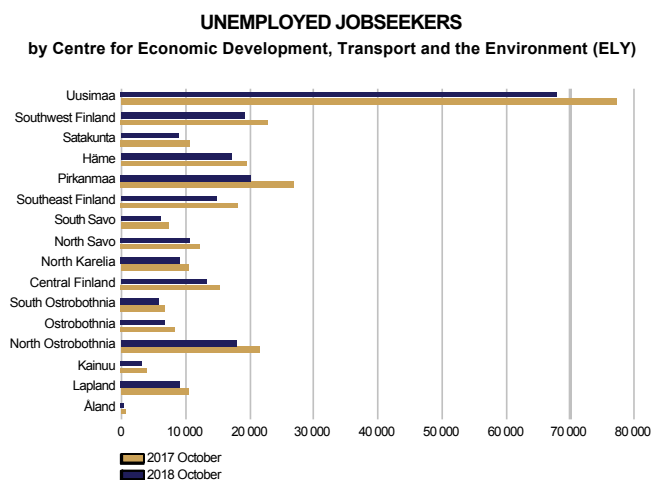
UNEMPLOYED JOBSEEKERS

Unemployment decreased in the areas of all ELY Centres

Compared to the same period in the previous year, the number of unemployed jobseekers decreased in October in the areas of all Centres for Economic Development, Transport and the Environment (ELY Centres); the most in Pirkanmaa (-25%), Ostrobothnia (-20%), Southeast Finland (-18%), South Ostrobothnia (-18%) and North Ostrobothnia (-18%).

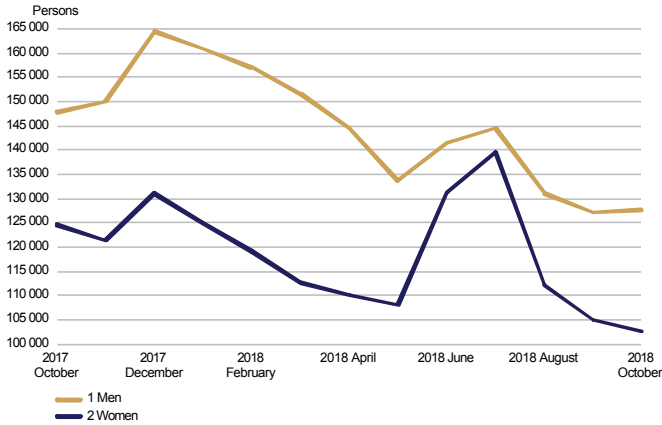

by gender**

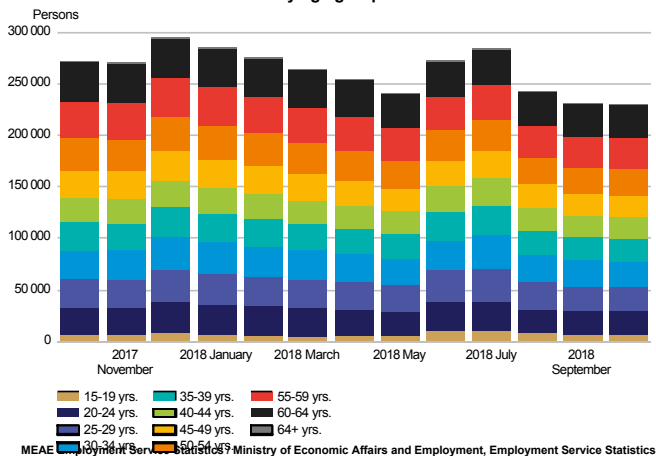

Unemployment decreased more among women than men

Of the unemployed jobseekers, 127,600 (55%) were men and 102,600 (45%) were women, indicating an increase of 400 for men and a decrease of 2,400 for women from the figures for September. Compared with October a year ago, the unemployment among men decreased by 20,300 (-14%) and among women by 22,100 (-18%).

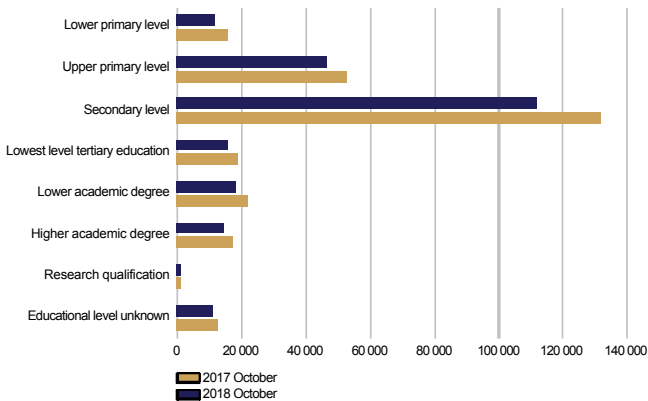
Unemployment decreased in all age groups

At the end of October, unemployed jobseekers under 25 years of age numbered 28,400, representing a decrease of 3,900 from October a year ago. Youth unemployment decreased from September by 600. For those under 20, the number of unemployed was 6,400. Among those over 50, the number of unemployed was 88,500, representing a decrease of 17,800 on the year before. Among those over 55, the number of unemployed was 62,200, representing a decrease of 12,600 on the year before.

by level of education

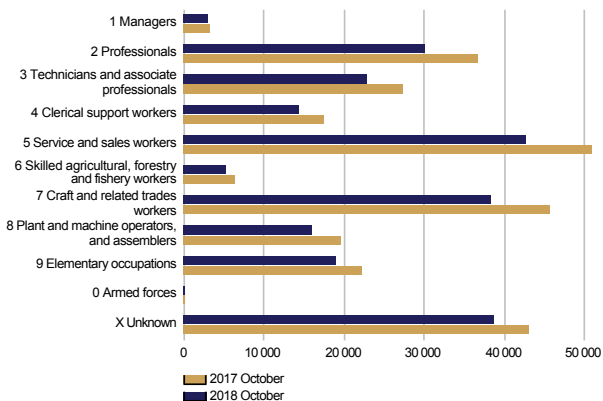

Unemployment decreased at all levels of education

Examined by level of education, unemployment decreased from October last year at all levels of education; the decrease was greatest among those with lower level basic qualifications (-29%), doctorate or equivalent level tertiary education (-18%), lowest level of tertiary education (-18%), higher-degree level tertiary education (-16%) and lower-degree level tertiary education (-16%).

by occupational group

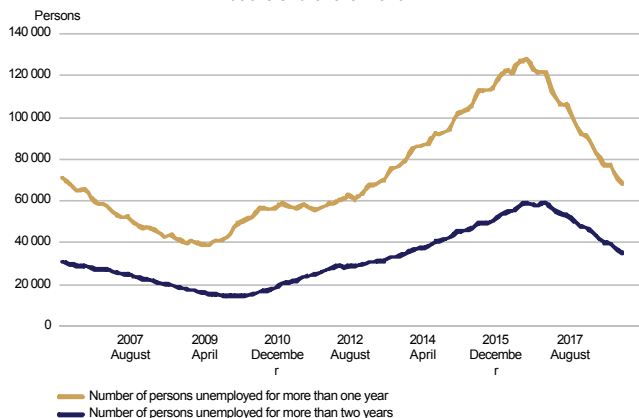

Unemployment decreased in all occupational groups

Examined by occupation, unemployment decreased in all groups from October last year; the most in the groups of service and sales workers (-8,300), craft and related trades workers (-7,400), professionals (-6,700), technicians and associate professionals (-4,700) and 'unknown' (-4,200).

Decrease in long-term unemployment

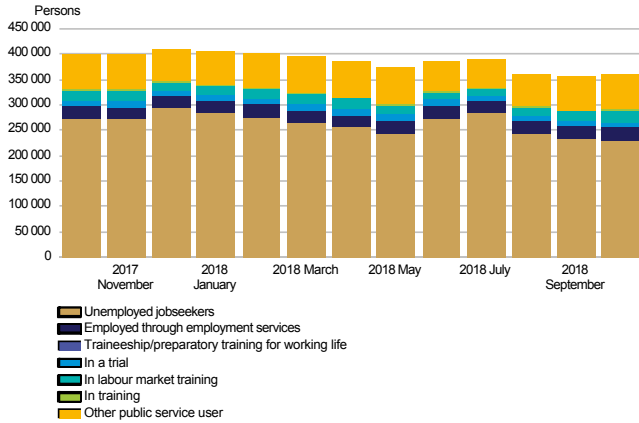
At the end of October, the number of long-term unemployed who had been unemployed without interruption for more than a year amounted to 68,400, down 26,300 from the previous year. Of the long-term unemployed, 40,200 were men and 28,200 were women. The number of men decreased by 13,800 (-26%) from the previous year and the number of women by 12,500 (-31%). Long-term unemployed who had been unemployed without interruption for more than two years numbered 35,100, which is 13,700 less than a year ago.

BROAD UNEMPLOYMENT

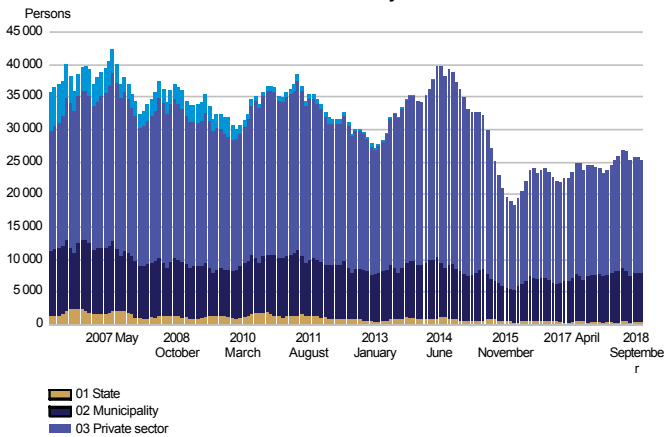
i.e. unemployed jobseekers and employment services users

Increase in the number of persons covered by services

At the end of October, the number of persons covered by services included in the activation rate amounted to 130,900, up 5,300 on the previous year. Compared with September, the number of persons covered by such services increased by 4,300. The activation rate at the end of October was 36.3%, which is 4.7 percentage points higher than a year earlier. In all, 4.8% of the labour force were covered by these services.

Of those covered by services, the number of men was 62,600, up 2,500 on the previous year. The number of women covered by these services was 68,400, up 2,700 on the previous year.

Broad unemployment, or the total number of unemployed jobseekers and those covered by services, was 361,100 at the end of October. This is 37,100 less than a year earlier. The decrease in broad unemployment was due to a decrease in the number of unemployed jobseekers.

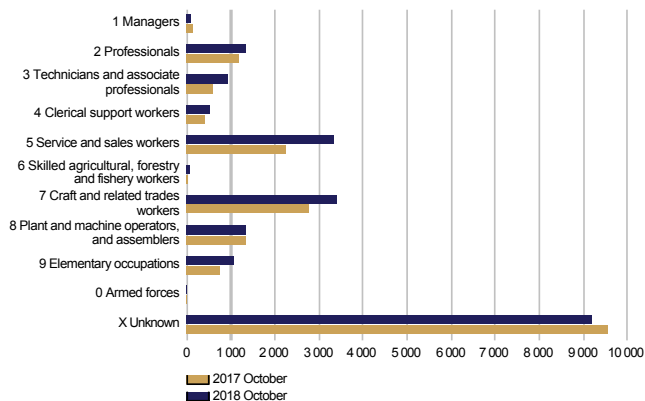
The number of placements increased in all sectors

At the end of October, the number of persons claiming pay subsidies, employed by the State or receiving start-up grants totalled 25,400, which is 1,100 more than the year before. Of those employed, 2% were in government jobs, 30% in local government jobs and 68% in the private sector. Since October last year, the number of placements has increased by 1% in government jobs, 4% in local government jobs and 5% in the private sector. Of those employed, 51% were men. Placements for men increased by 500, and those for women by 600 from the previous year.

in target profession at the end of the month



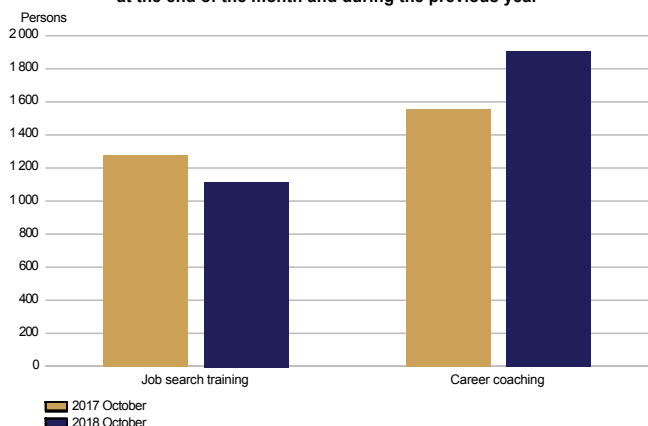

Increase in the number of persons in labour market training

At the end of October, labour market training was attended by 21,300 students, up 2,200 on the previous year. Of the students, 10,600 were men and 10,700 were women. Compared to the situation a year ago, the number of men increased by 700 and the number of women by 1,500. During October, 6,000 new students began labour market training, representing an increase of 300 on the year before.

Based on target occupation, the largest subgroup within the category of 'unknown' were people in integration training (7,300), which is 1,400 less than the year before.

at the end of the month and during the previous year

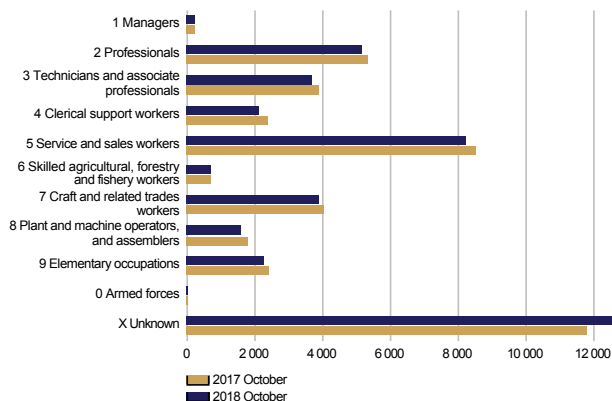

The number of persons in training increased

At the end of October, 3,000 persons were in training, which is 200 more than the year before. The number of men in training was 1,400 and of women 1,600. Career coaching had 1,900 participants, which is 400 more than a year earlier. The number of participants in job search training decreased by 200 from the previous year.

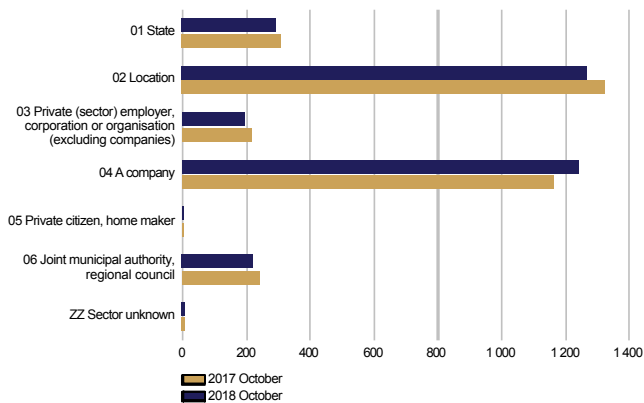
The number of people in self-motivated study decreased from the previous year

Self-motivated studies supported by unemployment benefits were attended by a total of 40,600 people, representing a decrease of 500 on the year before. The number of men receiving unemployment benefits for studies was 16,900, down 100 on the previous year. Among women, the number was 23,700, representing a decrease of 400 on the year before. Occupation was undetermined in case of 10,600 persons in the group of 'unknown', up 900 on the previous year.

at the end of the month and during the previous year by sector

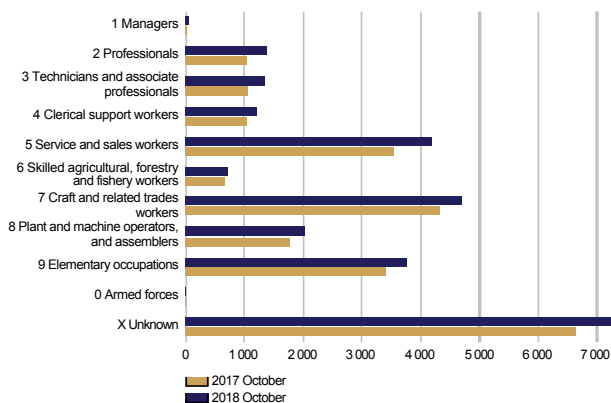

The number of job alternation substitutes decreased slightly

A total of 3,200 persons were job alternation substitutes at the end of October, which is almost the same as the year before. Of the substitutes, 1,100 were men and 2,100 were women. The number of men remained almost the same, and the number of women decreased by 100.

at the end of the month and during the previous year

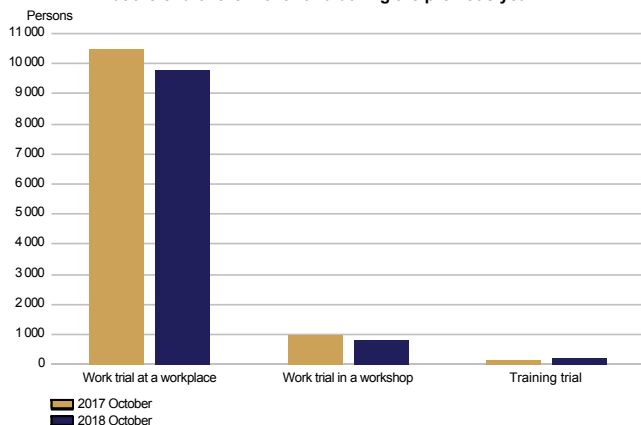

More participants in rehabilitative work activities than in the previous year

A total of 26,600 persons participated in rehabilitative work activities at the end of October, which is 3,100 more than a year earlier. Of the participants 14,800 were men and 11,800 were women. The number of men increased by 1,500 and the number of women by 1,600 from the previous year.

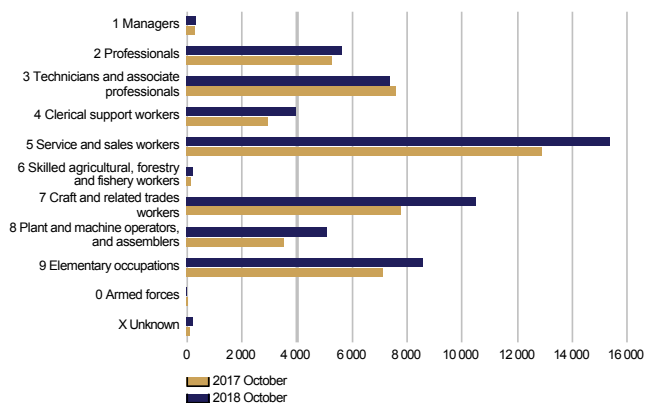
Participation in work and training trials decreased

Work and training trials had a total of 10,800 participants at the end of October, which is 800 less than the year before. Of the participants, 4,900 were men and 5,900 were women. The number of men decreased by 200 from the previous year and the number of women by 600.

Increase in the number of new vacancies

The number of new vacancies reported to Employment and Economic Development Offices during October totalled 57,100, which is 9,400 more than in October last year. In all, the number of unfilled vacancies at Employment and Economic Development Offices in October amounted to 103,800, which is 14,300 more than a year ago. A total of 8,600 of these vacancies were filled during October, 4,700 of them through Employment and Economic Development Offices. A total of 47,200 vacancies were closed for applications because the application period had ended or because there was a sufficient number of applicants. In addition, a total of 1,800 vacancies were cancelled and 1,700 vacancies could not be filled. The number of vacancies remaining unfilled at the end of October was 46,400, up 7,500 on the previous year.

The number of new vacancies had increased for nine occupational groups; the greatest increases were in the groups of craft and related trades workers (2,700), service and sales workers (2,500), plant and machine operators, and assemblers (1,600) and elementary occupations (1,400). The number of new job vacancies had decreased only in the categories of technicians and associate professionals (-300) and armed forces (-5).

Information about the website

On this website you will find the latest statistics from the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment's monthly Employment Bulletin. You can access a .pdf version of the current and previous months' Employment Bulletin by following the link on the right. The Employment Bulletin is based on the data from the MEAE's Employment Service Statistics. The Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment compiles statistics on the clients of the Employment and economic development offices (TE offices), including registered job-seekers, labour market policy services, and job vacancies reported to TE offices by employers. The data is collected from the customer service registry (URA) used by the TE offices. This means that the data used by MEAE Employment Service Statistics is completely registry-based. The statistical data covers all persons, services, and open vacancies in the aforementioned groups, as separately defined in the registry by the classifications and variables for the statistical period in question. The figures also include registered jobseekers who are taking part in local government trial schemes for promoting employment.

Owing to seasonal variations, the Employment Bulletin always includes a comparison with the corresponding month in the previous year. The descriptors used in the Bulletin are also available in a table format. The Employment Bulletins are published at the end of the subsequent calendar month. The official date of publication is announced in advance.
