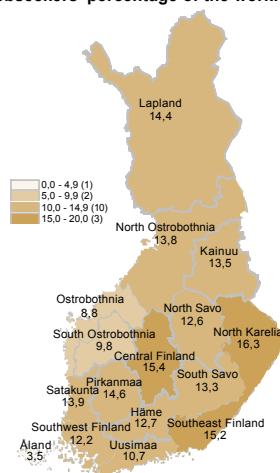

In November, the number of unemployed jobseekers was 328,500

A total of 328,500 unemployed jobseekers were registered at the Employment and Economic Development Offices at the end of November. This is 13,600 less than a year earlier. The number of unemployed jobseekers decreased by 400 from the previous month. Unemployed jobseekers accounted for 12.5% of the labour force which is 0.5 percentage points less than a year ago. The figures are from the Employment Service Statistics of the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment.

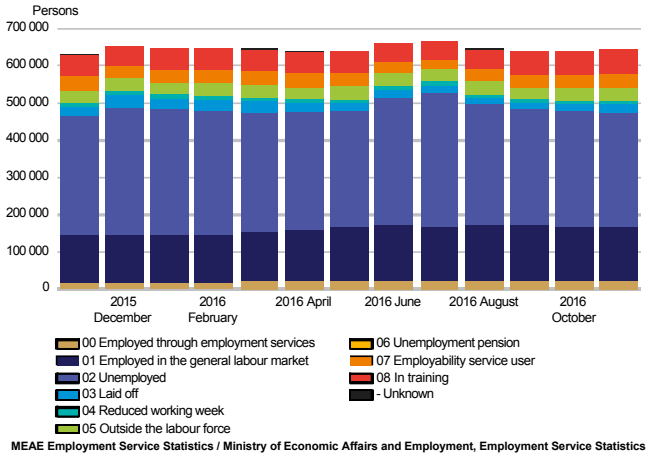

The total number of jobseekers increased

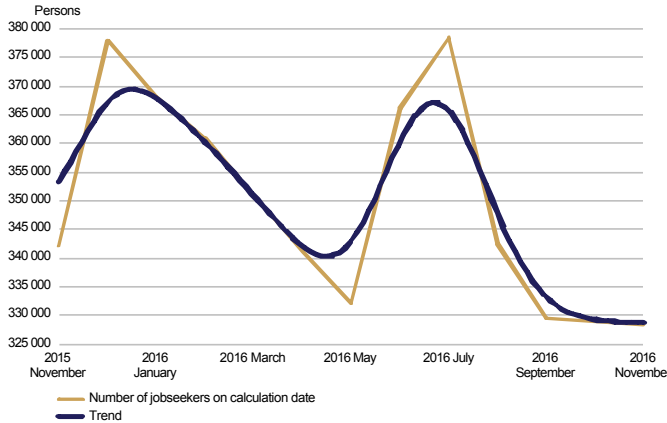
At the end of November, the number of unemployed jobseekers registered at the Employment and Economic Development Offices totalled 643,200, up 11,700 on the previous year. Of the jobseekers, 326,800 were men and 316,400 were women. Compared to the situation a year ago, the number of men increased by 300 and the number of women by 12,100.

Of the jobseekers, 168,400 were employed, 145,900 of them were on the open labour market and 22,600 were employed through the services of the employment and economic development administration. The number of jobseekers outside the labour force was 135,900, of whom 36,800 were in services promoting employment and 66,200 in training. Of the jobseekers, 328,500 were unemployed jobseekers, which is 13,600 less than the year before. In November, 21,200 of unemployed jobseekers were fully laid off, which is 1,500 more than in October. Since November of the year before, the number of people fully laid off has decreased by 4,100. Furthermore, jobseekers on a reduced working week numbered 10,300, representing a decrease of 100 from the year before.

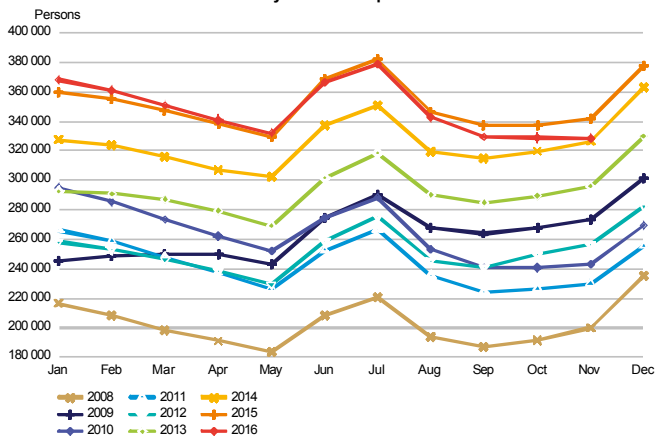
The number of unemployed jobseekers decreased in November

At the end of November, the number of unemployed jobseekers registered at the Employment and Economic Development Offices totalled 328,500, down 13,600 on the previous year. Since November of the year before, the number of people fully laid off has decreased by 400.

In November, 21,200 of unemployed jobseekers were fully laid off, which is 1,500 more than in October. Since November of the year before, the number of people fully laid off has decreased by 4,100.

The number of foreign citizens among unemployed jobseekers totalled 30,800, up 100 from November a year ago. Of these foreign unemployed jobseekers, EU/EEA citizens accounted for 9,500 at the end of November, down 200 from the year before.

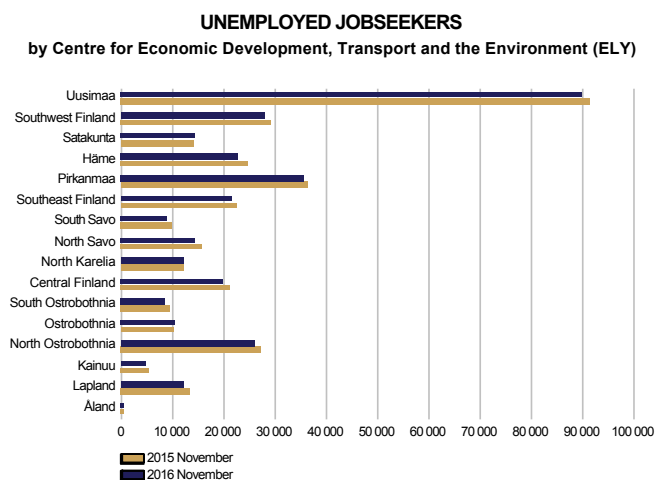
UNEMPLOYED JOBSEEKERS

Unemployment decreased in twelve areas

Compared to the same period in the previous year, the number of unemployed jobseekers decreased in November in the areas of twelve Centres for Economic Development, Transport and the Environment (ELY Centres); the most in Kainuu (-16%), South Ostrobothnia (-10%), Lapland (-10%), South Savo (-8%), Häme (-8%) and North Savo (-8%).

Correspondingly, unemployment increased only in Satakunta (3%), Ostrobothnia (2%) and North Karelia (1%).

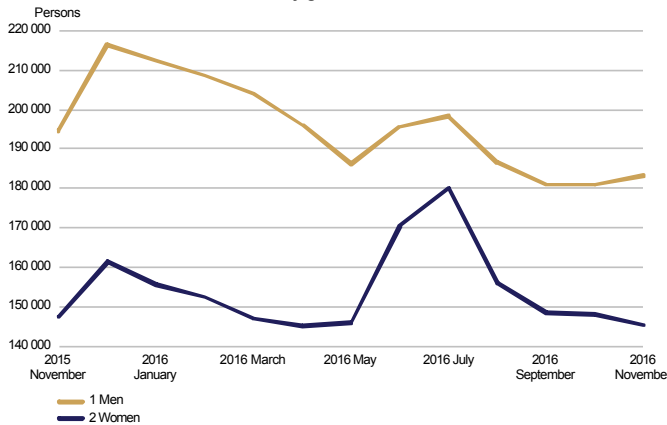

by gender**

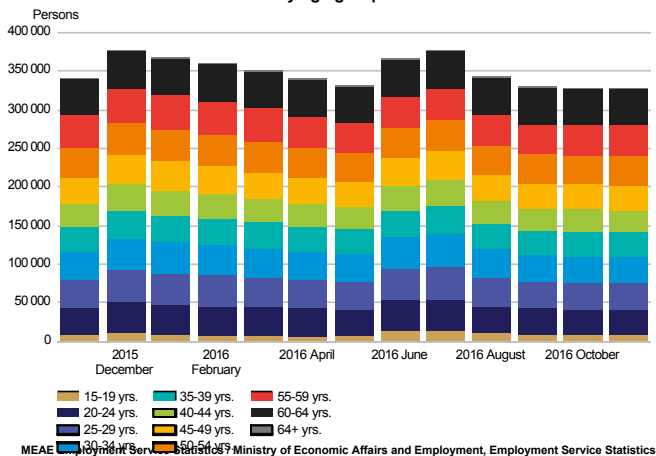

Unemployment decreased considerably more among men than women

Of the jobseekers, 183,300 (56%) were men and 145,200 (44%) were women indicating an increase of 2,400 for men and 2,800 for women compared to the figures in October. Compared with November a year ago, the unemployment among men decreased by 11,400 (-6%) and among women by 2,200 (-2%).

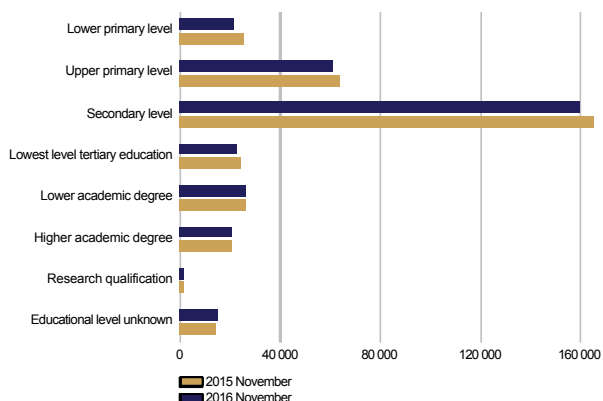
Unemployment decreased in all age groups

At the end of November, unemployed jobseekers under 25 years of age numbered 40,100 representing a decrease of 2,800 from November a year ago. Youth unemployment decreased from October by 900. For those under 20, the number of unemployed was 8,600. Among those over 50, the number of unemployed was 125,900, representing a decrease of 3,100 on the year before. Among those over 55, the number of unemployed was 88,400, representing a decrease of 1,900 on the year before.

by level of education

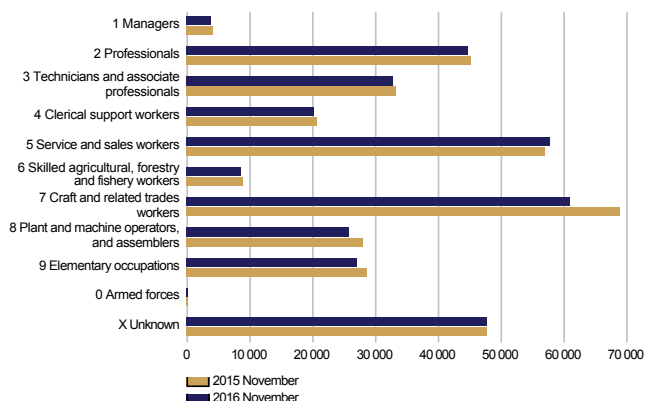

Unemployment increased slightly among those with a higher level of education

Examined by level of education, the unemployment decreased from November of last year among those with lower level basic qualifications (-15%), higher level basic qualifications (-4%), lowest level of tertiary education (-4%), upper secondary level of education (-4%) and lower-degree level tertiary education (-1%). Unemployment grew among those with doctorate or equivalent level tertiary education (2%) and higher-degree level tertiary education (0%).

by occupational group

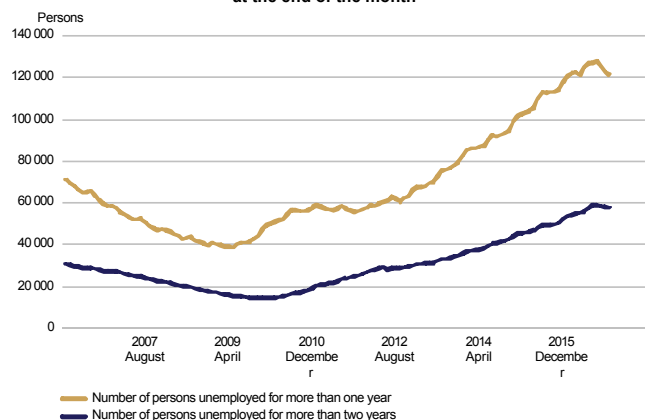

Unemployment decreased in ten occupational groups

Examined by occupation, unemployment decreased in ten groups from November last year; the most in the groups of construction, repair and manufacturing workers (-7,800), process and transport workers (-2,600) and other workers (-1,600). At the same time, unemployment grew only in the groups of service and sales personnel (700).

Long-term unemployment continued to grow

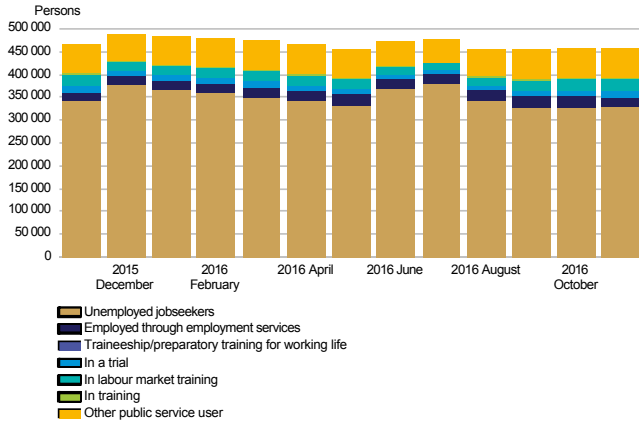
At the end of November, the number of long-term unemployed who had been unemployed without interruption for more than a year amounted to 121,500, up 7,100 on the previous year. Of the long-term unemployed, 70,500 were men and 50,900 were women. The number of men increased by 3,400 (5%) from the previous year and the number of women by 3,800 (8%). Long-term unemployed who had been unemployed without interruption for more than two years numbered 57,800, which is 7,300 more than a year ago.

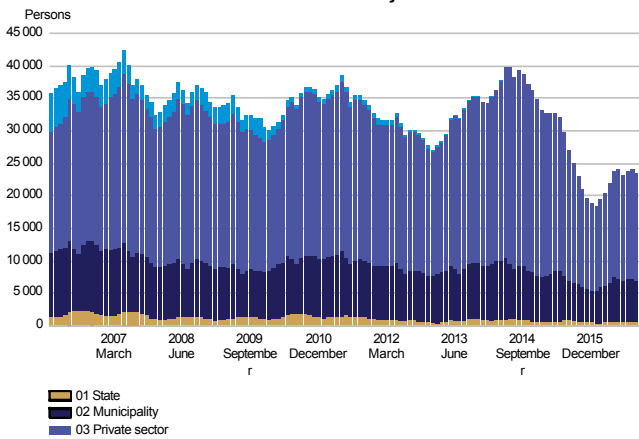
An increase in the number of persons covered by services

At the end of November, the number of persons covered by services included in the activation rate amounted to 129,400, up 7,200 on the previous year. Compared with October, the number of persons covered by such services increased by 600. The activation rate at the end of November was 28.3 %, which is 2.0 percentage points higher than a year earlier. In all, 4.9% of the labour force was covered by these services.

Of those covered by services, the number of men was 61,500, up 3,600 on the previous year. The number of women covered by these services was 67,900, up 3,600 on the previous year.

Broad unemployment, or the total number of unemployed jobseekers and those covered by services, was 457,900 at the end of November. This is 6,300 less than a year earlier. The decrease in broad unemployment was due to a decrease in the number of unemployed jobseekers.

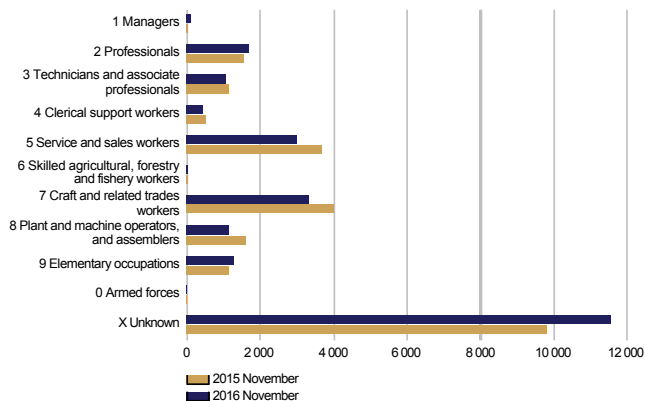
The number of placements increased in local government and the private sector

At the end of November, the number of persons claiming pay subsidies, employed by the State or receiving start-up grants totalled 22,900, which is 3,100 more than the year before. Of those employed, 2% were in government jobs, 26% in local government jobs and 71% in the private sector. Since November last year, the number of placements has decreased by 8% in government jobs and increased by 18% in local government jobs and by 16% in the private sector. Of those employed, 52% were men. Placements for men increased by 1,600, and those for women by 1,500 from the previous year.

in target profession at the end of the month



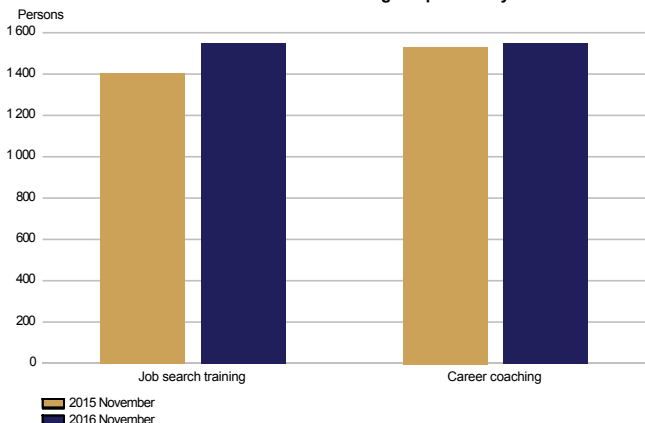

Slight increase in labour market training

At the end of November, labour market training was attended by 23,700 students, up 100 on the previous year. Of the students, 12,200 were men and 11,500 were women. Compared to the situation a year ago, the number of men increased by 200 and the number of women decreased by 100. During November, 5,000 new students began labour market training, representing an increase of 800 on the year before.

Based on target occupation, the largest subgroup within the category of 'unknown' were people in integration training (9,300), which is 1,400 more than the year before. In November, the number of people without a specified target occupation was 900, which is 100 less than in November last year.

at the end of the month and during the previous year

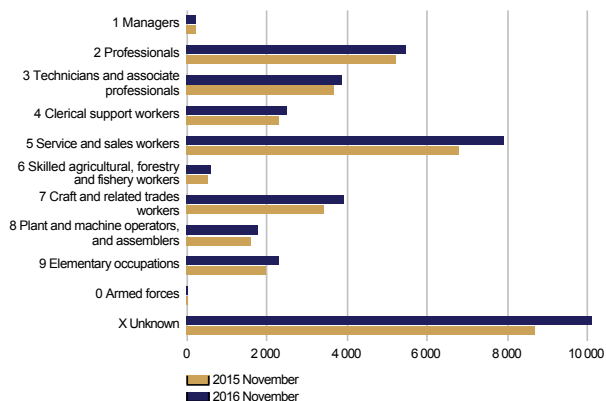

The number of persons in training increased

At the end of November, 3,100 persons were in training, which is 200 more than the year before. The number of men in training was 1,600 and of women 1,500. Work and training trials had 1,500 participants, which is almost as many as the year before. The number of participants in job search training increased by 100 compared to November last year.

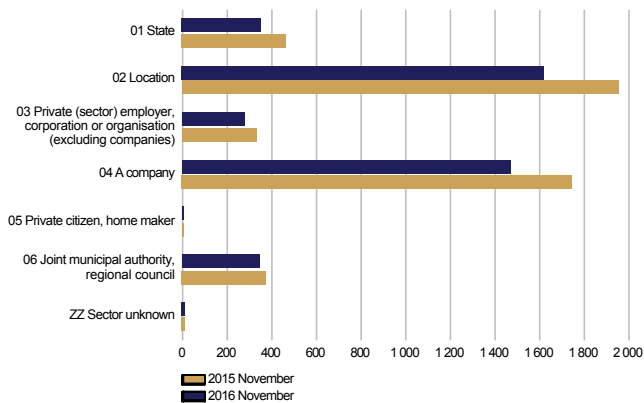
The number of people in self-motivated study increased from the previous year

Self-motivated studies supported by unemployment benefits were attended by a total of 38,700 people, representing an increase of 4,200 on the year before. The number of men receiving unemployment benefits for studies was 15,400, up 1,900 on the previous year. Among women, the number was 23,300, representing an increase of 2,400 on the year before. Occupation was undetermined in case of 8,100 persons in the group of 'unknown', up 1,300 on the previous year.

at the end of the month and during the previous year by sector

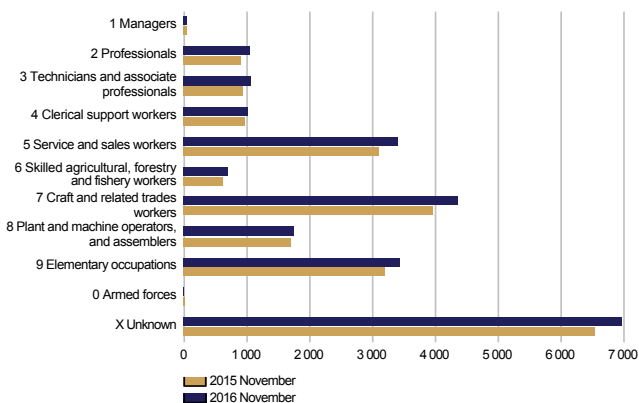

The number of job alternation substitutes decreased

A total of 4,100 persons were job alternation substitutes at the end of November, which is 800 less than a year earlier. Of the substitutes, 1,300 were men and 2,800 were women. The number of men decreased by 200, and the number of women by 600.

at the end of the month and during the previous year

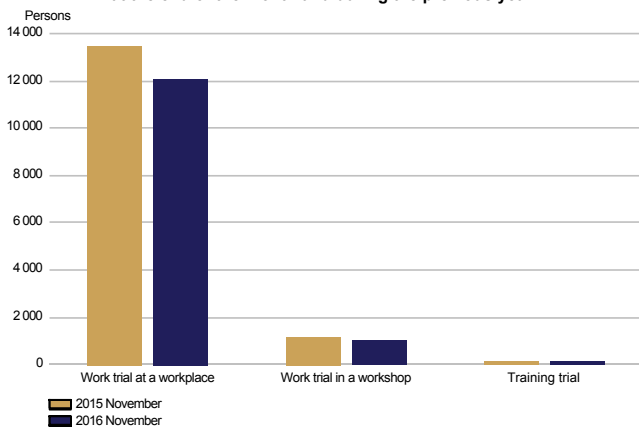

More participants in rehabilitative work activities than in the previous year

A total of 23,700 persons participated in rehabilitative work activities at the end of November, which is 1,800 more than a year earlier. Of the participants 13,500 were men and 10,200 were women. The number of both men and women increased by 900 from the previous year.

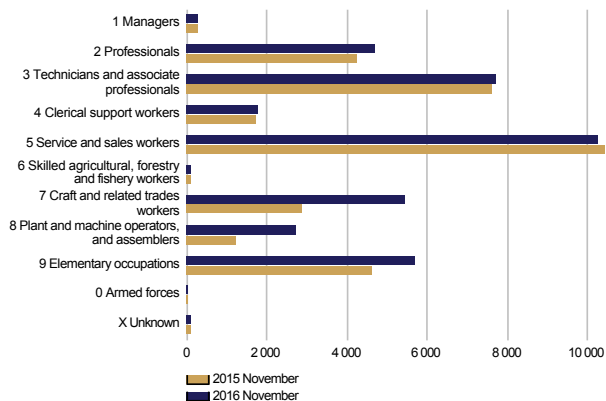
Participation in work and training trials decreased

Work and training trials had a total of 13,300 participants at the end of November, which is 1,400 less than the year before. Of the participants 5,800 were men and 7,500 were women. The number of men decreased by 700, and the number of women by 700.

Increase in the number of new vacancies

The number of new vacancies reported to Employment and Economic Development Offices during November totalled 38,700, which is 5,500 more than November in the previous year. In all, the number of unfilled vacancies at Employment and Economic Development Offices amounted to 69,000 in November, which is 8,800 more than a year ago. A total of 7,600 of these vacancies were filled during November, 3,300 of them through Employment and Economic Development Offices. A total of 29,700 vacancies were closed for applications because the application period had ended or because there was a sufficient number applicants. In addition, a total of 1,300 vacancies were cancelled and 1,100 vacancies could not be fulfilled. The number of vacancies remaining unfilled at the end of November was 30,100, up 4,200 on the previous year.

The number of new vacancies had increased for eight occupational groups; the greatest increases were in the groups of construction, repair and manufacturing workers (2,500), process and transport workers (1,500), other workers (1,100) and specialised experts (400). The number of new job vacancies had decreased most in the category of service and sales personnel (-200).

Information about the website

On this website you will find the latest statistics from the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment's monthly Employment Bulletin. You can access a .pdf version of the current and previous months' Employment Bulletin by following the link on the right. The Employment Bulletin is based on the data from the MEAE's Employment Service Statistics. The Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment compiles statistics on the clients of the Employment and economic development offices (TE offices), including registered job-seekers, labour market policy services, and job vacancies reported to TE offices by employers. The data is collected from the customer service registry (URA) used by the TE offices. This means that the data used by MEAE Employment Service Statistics is completely registry-based. The statistical data covers all persons, services, and open vacancies in the aforementioned groups, as separately defined in the registry by the classifications and variables for the statistical period in question.

Owing to seasonal variations, the Employment Bulletin always includes a comparison with the corresponding month in the previous year. The descriptors used in the Bulletin are also available in a table format. The Employment Bulletins are published at the end of the subsequent calendar month. The official date of publication is announced in advance.
